CENTRAL SOURCES

UPDATE SEPTEMBER 2021

There are new Central Sources added to the terrestrial channels and radios.

The first source is a ship-wide Chromecast that allows ship-wide streaming of video and audio through Chromecast from Android and Apple devices, if supported, including but not limited to Netflix / Spotify / Plex services which are used onboard.

The second source is also a Chromecast connected to the same encoder for Owner's leisure and there is also a new AirPlay channel that uses the existing Shipwide AirPlay allowing streaming of video and audio to areas where a local amplifier does not exist, such as External Saloons 443 and 300.

Chromecast

We now have a central Chromecast named SHIPWIDE 1 (more to be added) from the **Dream**Guest Wi-Fi. From the Crestron iPad go to

Watch → TV → Terrestrial and select SHIPWIDE 1

Chromecast.



From any supported application press the cast button and select Shipwide 1. This stream can be viewed anywhere on the ship and can be controlled from **Dream Guest Wi-Fi** connected devices. Allow some time for the device to connect and the stream to commence. Then the movie can be controlled from the entertainment device.



Airplay

The Apple TV previously used as Shipwide Airplay radio also has been added as TV channel allowing external areas that have a TV to take advantage of ship-wide IPTV streaming and view streamed video even without a local amplifier. From the Crestron iPad go to Watch TV Terrestrial and select Airplay. Ship-wide Airplay is controlled from Dream Guest Wi-Fi.

From Entertainment press Airplay or Bluetooth button and select Shipwide Airplay.
